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# Willamette Farm & Food Coalition's 2015-2016 Farm to Institution Local Purchasing Report

Willamette Farm and Food Coalition (WFFC) works with Lane County schools to incorporate fresh, locally grown and processed foods into school meals. With 53% of students in Lane County qualifying for free or reduced price lunch through the National School Lunch Program, the freshness and quality of school meals is more important than ever. For producers, this need presents an opportunity to get locally grown food into the mouths of school children in Lane County, creating a new market for crops and helping connect kids with the source of their food. There are opportunities for Lane County processors as well.

WFFC supports school districts with their local food purchases by facilitating relationships among Lane County farmers, processors and food service directors, helping schools map product needs with local sources of those products. Throughout each school year, WFFC tracks Lane County school districts' purchases by obtaining data from local food distributors, school districts, and the Oregon Department of Education. We compile this data into our annual "Farm to Institution Local Purchasing Report" to capture the impact that schools have on the local food economy. Below is just a snapshot of the impact that schools can have when they commit to buying local!



**Lane County grown produce** sold to area schools totaled **\$45,337**, slightly lower due in part to the loss of a few farms that previously sold large quantities to schools

**Oregon processed products** reached over **\$495,500** in sales to Lane County schools

**Oregon milk** has continued to stay steady at **\$661,339**

**Oregon raised meat** was purchased at an all-time high this year with over **\$31,615** spent

## 2015–2016 Farm to Institution Local Purchasing Report

**Bethel School District** has consistently been a strong supporter of local farms and food businesses. In the 2015-2016 school year, the district spent 30% of its food budget on Oregon grown or processed food and 19% on Lane County products. The district also spent \$13,872 on locally raised beef from Painted Hills Natural Beef, an increase of more than \$8,000 from the year before! And with the Bethel Farm coming online (with support from WFFC and other community partners), the amount and value of locally sourced products are sure to keep increasing.

**Eugene 4J School District** has continued to develop new relationships with local food vendors year after year. In the 2015-2016 school year, the district bought over \$10,000 worth of muffin mix produced by Camas Country Mill. This added to the district spending more than 32% of its food budget on locally grown or processed foods.

**Springfield Public Schools** purchased over \$54,000 worth of Oregon produce in the 2015-2016 school year! Springfield has continued to build their relationship with local farms and purchases apples from Detering Orchards consistently. This past year, the district bought over 7,000 pounds of apples from Detering Orchards! WFFC's support has also strengthened the district's relationships with the FOOD for Lane County Youth Farm and Springfield YTP Transition Garden Project, a district-managed garden that involves high school students in food production and other skills training.

**South Lane School District** purchased almost twice as much locally grown produce during the 2015-2016 school year with a total of \$11,552, compared to \$6,400 worth of produce purchased during the 2014-2015 school year. South Lane School District bought \$2,280 worth of grapes from Coast Fork Vineyard & Berry Farm during the school year, a farm that is located right outside of Cottage Grove.

**Junction City School District** has increased its local purchases every year since they started working with WFFC and our Harvest of the Month program. In the 2015-2016 school year, Junction City School District purchased over \$11,600 of locally grown produce—that's an increase of almost \$2,000 from the 2014-2015 school year.

**The Village School** has continued to be a champion of local food purchases. During the 2015-2016 school year, The Village School spent 85% of its food budget on locally grown and processed foods! They purchase from farms such as Sweet Leaf Organic Farm and Horton Road Organics. They also purchase legumes and grains from Hummingbird Wholesale.

**Other school districts'** purchases in Lane County reached an all-time high this year, due to increased tracking and funding through the Oregon Department of Education Farm to School Oregon Food Grant, which awarded school districts funds to buy local food. Totals for other school districts combined reached \$365,148 for the 2015-2016 school year.
